ITIA possesses basic training facilities to cater for crop and livestock disciplines including books, computers, audio visual equipment, farm machinery, tutorial rooms, laboratories, transport pools, banana plantations, forestry, coffee plantation, piggery unit, dairy farm, and workshop that make possible for the institute to match with the curriculum in practical training.

The institute is recognized by the National Council for Technical Education (NACTE) as a private institution with full registration (Cert.No. **REG/ANE/018**) and Vocational Education and Training Authority (VETA)(Cert.No. **VET/KGR/PR/2019/C/070**)

NACTE COURSES

- ⇒ **Basic Technician Certificate in Agriculture Production (NTA level 4)**

- Holders of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with passes in at least TWO (2) science subjects such as Agriculture, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Geography, Engineering Sciences and Nutrition and at least TWO (2) passes in other non religious subjects.

- Applicants who have undergone prior training in agriculture in recognized vocational training centres and attained National Vocation Awards (NVA) Level III should have a minimum of four passes of Form IV.

- ⇒ **Technician Certificate in Animal Health and Production (NTA level 5)**

Holders of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with four (4) passes in non-religious subjects including TWO (2) "D" Passes in Biology, Chemistry, Physics/ Engineering Sciences, Basic Mathematics, Agriculture Science and Geography; OR Holder of National Vocation Award (NVA) Level III or Trade Test Grade I in Animal Health.

- ⇒ **Ordinary Diploma in Animal Health and Production (NTA level 6)**

Holders of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with four (4) passes in non-religious subjects including TWO (2) "D" Passes in Biology, Chemistry, Physics/ Engineering Sciences, Basic Mathematics, Agriculture Science and Geography; OR Possession of National Vocation Award (NVA) Level III or Trade Test Grade I in Animal Health AND Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with TWO passes.

- ⇒ **Ordinary Diploma in Agriculture production (Diploma of Two years) (NTA level 6)**

Minimum qualification of Diploma of two years is a form six with ONE(1) principal pass and ONE (1) subsidiary pass in science subjects (Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Geography, Agriculture science and Nutrition) in Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE).

- ⇒ **Ordinary Diploma in Agriculture production (Diploma of One year) (NTA level 6)**

Holders of Technician Certificate in General Agriculture or Holders of Technician Certificate in Agriculture production (NTA LEVEL 5) with minimum GPA of 2.0

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Your application form will be processed to NACTE through Students Verification System therefore; you are required to fill in your correctly details and make an attachment of your particulars during submission of your application form at the Institute.

Short courses

These are tailor made courses of different duration meant for applications of between the class seven of Primary School Education and form four IV of Secondary School Education with good understanding of mathematics, English and General sciences based on the demands of the trainees and their ability to meet costs and who after training improve their understanding and performance in different walks of life.
